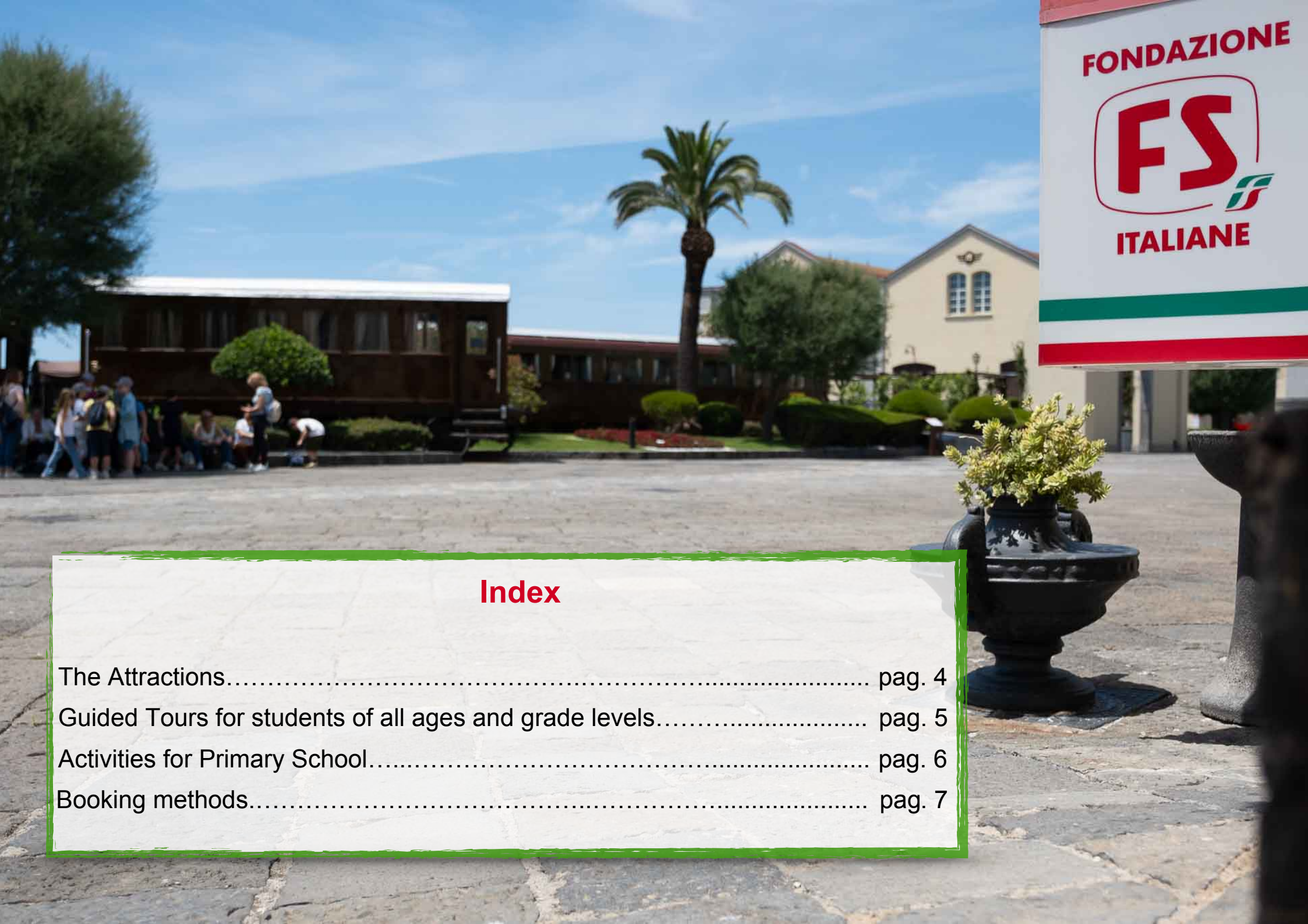

Exploring the National Railway Museum of Pietrarsa

Discovering the National Railway Museum of Pietrarsa means to retrace the history of Italian railways: near this place, on October 3rd, 1839, the first Italian railway line, from Naples to Portici, was inaugurated. The Royal Bourbon Mechanical and Pyrotechnic Factory was founded here in 1840 by King Ferdinand II, and today, thanks to the splendid collection it houses, it represents one of the most important European railway museums.

The Attractions

Virtual Tour

The virtual tour tells in Italian or in English the story and the functioning of the Bayard, one of the first steam locomotives that travelled along the Naples-Portici line in 1839.
